Boulevard Gardening

The Residential Boulevard Gardening Program is an opportunity for Edmontonians to add character to their neighbourhoods by beautifying the City's strip of land between the sidewalk and the road. This program provides Edmontonians with additional City space to create colourful, diverse streetscapes to strengthen community pride, ecological diversity, and build climate resiliency. To ensure safe and accessible spaces for everyone, the City has developed program requirements that outline the steps for gardening on the City's boulevard. In other words, you will require a permit—either a Declaration or a Licence of Occupation (LOO).

Looking for fun this summer? Think GREEN.


